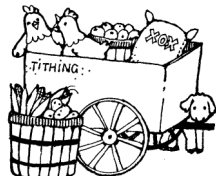
August 2—Gold Panning and Mining

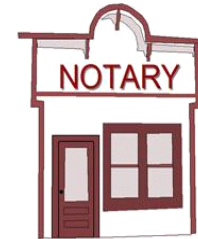
August 9—Trades and Supplies
